

Read the brief extract about Arthur C Clark. Write the necessary information in the space given below. (05 marks)

Arthur Charles Clarke was born in England on 16th December 1917, to Charles Wright Clarke & Nora Mary (Willis). Clarke's father died when he was fourteen.

Clarke started to write "fantastic" stories. He became interested in science in early age, and constructed his first telescope at thirteen. In 1936 he moved to London after attending Huish's Grammar School but he lacked the means for higher education.

He worked as a government auditor. Clarke served in the Royal Air Force and from 1941 to 1946 becoming a radar instructor and technician. While in the service he published his first science-fiction.

After the war Clarke entered King's College, London, and took his B.Sc. in 1948. His first book "Interplanetary Flight" was published in 1950, which is non-fictional.

In the middle of 1950s Clarke was interested in undersea exploration. In 1954 Clarke set sail for Australia to dive on the Great Barrier Reef and in 1955 dived off the coast of Sri Lanka. He moved to Sri Lanka in 1956.

In 1973 Clarke received all three of the major Sci-Fi awards (the Hugo, the Nebula Awards and the John W. Campbell Memorial Award) and BSFA award for his novel "Rendezvous with Rama".




