
Countries in the Northern hemisphere, below the Arctic Circle have four clearly defined seasons. In this Northern zone summer usually lasts from June to August. The long hours of daylight at that time of the year are often combined with long periods of settled weather and temperature averages around $20~{\rm C}^{\rm o}$ though there are often days with the temperature as high as $30~{\rm C}^{\rm o}$.

The days become noticeably short in September and in the autumn the trees are very beautiful as the green leaves turn to dark gold. The first frost usually come in the nights of October and falls of snow quite common in November.

However, by December, snow and daytime frost covered ground for about three months. The winter day temperatures keep below freezing point and move around -5 C° and -10 C°. On cold days the temperature may go down to -20 C° even -30 C°, but it is not common.

The spring comes fairly quickly. The ground is usually clear by the end of April. Buds and flowers come slowly at first, but in May there is a great burst of growth with the long daylight hours. There is also a rapid rate of blossoming, though frost may occur until the beginning of June.





Hikkaduwa Coral Reef

Hikkaduwa coral reef is a typical shallow <u>fringing reef</u> with an average depth of around 5 meters. The coral reef reduces the <u>coastal erosion</u> and forms a natural <u>breakwater</u>. The coast of the national park extends four km. Generally the coast is narrow, ranging from 5–50 m according to the climatic conditions of the year. <u>Scuba diving</u> is a popular recreation here.

The national park situated in the <u>wet zone</u> and receives a 2,000 millimeters of annual rainfall. The rain is received in both southwestern and northeastern <u>monsoon</u> seasons. Inter-monsoon season is a dry period which is considered the best season to visit the park. The temperature of the water ranges from 28.0°-30.0 °C while the mean annual temperature is 27 °C of the atmosphere.

Foliaceous <u>Montipora</u> species dominate the coral reef. <u>Staghorn</u>, <u>elkhorn</u>, cabbage, <u>brain</u>, table and star corals are all present in the reef. Corals of 60 species belonging to 31 genera are recorded from the reef. The reef also recorded over 170 species of reef fish belonging to 76 genera.




