





**PLASTIC**

People use plastic every day. Water bottles, sandwich bags and food containers are common plastic items. Plastic waste means plastic that is thrown away. When plastic is buried in the ground it takes many years to decay as plastic is very strong and can last for a long time. Plastic is made from oil or natural gases found deep in the earth. Oil is mixed with chemicals and then heated. This mixture becomes liquid plastic. This liquid can be molded into different shapes according to the need.

Scientists are starting to use corn oil and natural sugar to make plastic. The plastic made out of these may decay faster than plastic made from oil taken from earth. Plastic made from corn oil is better for the environment.

Plastic can be recycled. When plastic is recycled it is melted down and is used to make new items. Most countries have recycling programme for plastic, paper, glass and metal. Recycled plastic can be used to make carpets, bin bags, combs and insulation. Plastic can also be burnt for fuel to make electricity. By recycling plastic waste we can help to keep our planet clean.


