(1) Ukraine claims to have retaken areas near Kyiv amid fear of traps.

UKRAINE: Ukrainian troops moved cautiously to retake territory north of the country's capital on Saturday, using cables to pull the bodies of civilians off the streets in one town out of fear that Russiaan forces might have boody-trapped them before leaving.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy warned in his nightly video address hours earlier that departing Russian troops were creating a "catastrophic" situation for civilians by leaving mines around homes, abandoned equipment and "even the bodies of those killed." His claims could not be independently verified. Associated press journalists in Bucha, a suburb northwest of Kyiv, watched Saturday as Ukrainian soldiers backed by a column of thanks and other armored vehicles used cables to drag bodies off of a street from a distance, fearing they might have been rigged to explode. Locals said the dead – the AP counted at least six – were civilians who were killed by departing Russian soldiers whout provocation.

(2) STF nabs five with smuggled cigarettes.

Police Special task Force (STF) officers of Sri Jayawardenepura on a tip-off arrested five suspects along with two lorries bearing false number plates and a bulk of illegally imported cigarettes at Peliyagoda on Friday night.

The officers had recovered 3,990,000 sticks of cigarettes in their possession.

The suspects arrested are of the ages of 30, 34, 35, 46 and 48 and are residents of Colombo, Wattala, Kalubowila, Beruwala and Maggona.

They were to be produced before the Aluthkade No. 5 Magistrate on Saturday. Monday, April 22nd, 2022






The following pie chart shows the passengers of children of Sirimavo Balika Vidyalaya using different modes of transport. (10 marks)


