- Professor Nandasena Rathnapala, born in the remote village of Kurukude in Bandarawela, made remarkable contributions to Sinhala literature, sociology, folklore, anthropology, and criminology. Later, he attended Royal College, Colombo, where he studied alongside notable contemporaries such as Norman Weerasooriya, Singaruwele, and Lalith Athulathmudali.
