



Colony Life of a Honeybee

Life in the colony is entirely dependent upon the time of year. Honeybee colonies can get all their resources from flowers. As a result, the life cycle of the colony follows the life cycle of flowering plants in the environment. All spring honeybees start to build their work force in preparation for the bloom of spring flowers. In summer, honeybees ramp up resource collection and are at their largest and most active. In the fall, bees start to slow down collection as the temperature starts to get cooler and flowers start to become less abundant. A large honeybee colony is an impressive sight. European honeybees, *apis mellifera*, common to Europe and North America, can have colonies containing over 60,000 individuals. Inside the colony there are hanging sheets of comb with its hexagon cells. There are bees busy working the honey-filled cells on both sides. Some of the worker bees are building new cells while other bees are tending to the young larvae. A very large bee is moving from cell to cell laying eggs. This is the queen.



Read the following text and answer the questions given below.

Can you imagine a world without oceans to swim in and explore? Oceans are home to seahorses, dolphins, whales, corals, and many other living creatures. Oceans are our planet's life support as they provide water, food and help regulate the weather. Oceans also provide jobs for more than 3 billion people who depend on marine biodiversity for their livelihood. If we do not stop polluting our oceans, there will be severe problems that affect every person and living creature on the planet.

Pollution poses the greatest threat to our planet and the lives of future generations! Do you ever ask yourself where all the plastic bottles and bags go after you use them? Every year an estimated 5 to 12 million metric tons of plastic enter the ocean. Carbon emissions produced by human activities, like driving cars, are causing the oceans to warm and increase the acid level in the water. This is extremely bad for animals and organisms that live in the sea, as the acid can break the organisms' shells and damage coral reefs.

Marine pollution caused by plastic substances is recognized as an issue of the highest magnitude, from a pollution perspective. A lot of the plastic that are used in people's day to day lives are never recycled, up to 90% and over 8 million metric tons of plastic waste is thrown into the ocean every year. If this continues, then by the year 2050 there will be more plastic than fish in the world by weight. In just the first decade of the century, more plastic has been created than all the plastic in history up until the year of 2000 and a majority of that plastic is not recycled. There is an estimated 15 to 51 trillion pieces of plastic amongst all of the world's oceans stretching from the top of ocean to the seafloor. Oceans are Earth's deepest and most extensive basins with average depths of the abyssal plains being about 4 km beneath sea level. Gravity will naturally move and transfer materials from land to the ocean, with the ocean becoming the end-repository. One estimate of the historic production of plastic gives a figure of 8,300 million metric tonnes (Mt) for global plastic production up to 2015, of which 79% have been accumulated in landfills or the natural environment.

All of us need to help to protect our seas. You can suggest to your parents not to use plastic bottles at home, but use a filter instead, if your tap water allows. Next time you go to the beach, bring a reusable bag to collect garbage, so <u>it</u> does not enter the water.


