Pigeon Island National Park Sri Lanka

Pigeon Island National Park is one of the two marine national parks of Sri Lanka. The national park is situated 1 km off the coast of Nilaveli; a coastal town in Eastern Province These two islands of the Pigeon Island National Park are named the large pigeon island and the small pigeon island. The islands were designated as a national park in 2003.

Pigeon Island National Park encompasses an area of 417.429 hectares. It contains some of the best remaining coral reefs of Sri Lanka. Since the most rain is received during the North-eastern monsoon from October to March, the ideal time to visit the park is during the dry weather from April to September.

The two islands of this marine park are surrounded by coral reefs. The reef is home to many aquatic species; with many of the 100 species of corals and 300 species of reef fishes and other

aquatic animals such as the black tip reef shark, hawksbill turtle, green turtle and olive ridley. Pigeon Island National Park is a popular among tourists as an ideal spot for marine recreation activities such as scuba diving, snorkelling, surfing and boat rides.

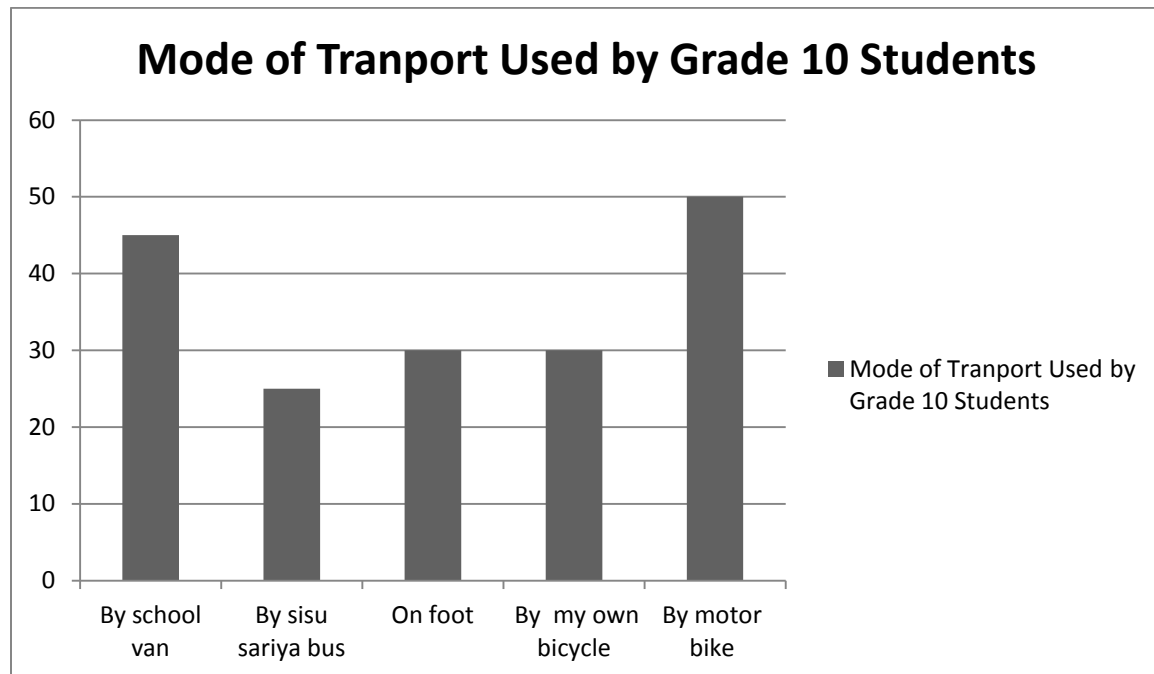
