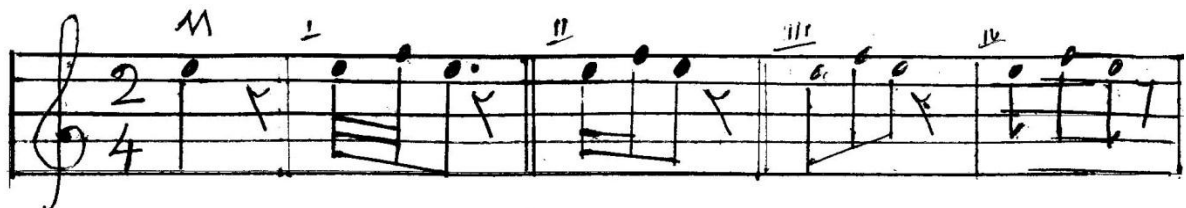

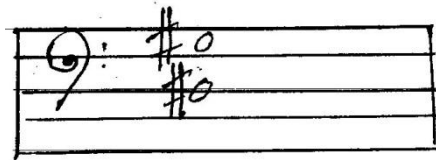

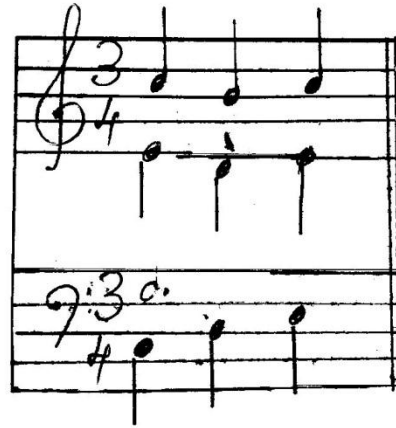

### COUNTRY DANCE (1770-1827)




