Isaac Newton was born in Lincolnshire, England in 1643. When he was a boy, he made lots of brilliant **inventions** like a windmill to grind corn and a water clock. However, Isaac didn't get brilliant marks at school. When he was 18, Isaac went to study at Cambridge University. He was very interested in physics, mathematics and astronomy.

But in 1665 the Great Plague, which was a terrible disease, spread in England, and Cambridge University had to close down. Isaac continued studying and experimenting at home. One day he was drinking a cup of tea in the garden. He saw an apple fall from a tree. 'Why do apples fall down instead of up?' From this, he formed the theory of gravity.

Isaac was fascinated by light. He discovered that white light is in fact made up of all the colours of the rainbow. Isaac also invented a special reflecting telescope, using mirrors. It was much more powerful than other telescopes.

Thanks to his discoveries, Isaac became rich and famous. However, he had a bad **temper** and often argued with other scientists. Sir Isaac Newton died in 1727 aged 85. He was buried along with English kings and queens in Westminster Abbey in London. He was one of the greatest scientists and mathematicians who had ever lived.
